Tarangire, Ngorongoro Crater,
Serengeti NP


Overview

The Tarangire National Park, features some of the greatest concentration of game in Tanzania – second only to the Ngorongoro Crater – but less crowded and unspoiled – possessing a wild and unkempt beauty. It will be our first stop before this safari will take you to the Serengeti National Park, a massive wilderness of 14500 square km, where every day brings a new landscape and a new adventure. It will also take you to the Ngorongoro Crater and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area in Tanzania, featuring one of the highest concentrations of game and arguably the densest population of predators and carnivores in Africa. Here you will witness an amazing spectacle of African wildlife – inside a self-contained world teeming with animals.

Day 1 Arrival and Transfer to Kaliwa Lodge, Kilimanjaro

You will be picked up from Kilimanjaro International Airport followed by a transfer to Mt. Kilimanjaro, Machame Area.

Depending on your arrival time you may optionally visit different parts on the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro; for example Coffee and Banana plantations. You can also test the Kilimanjaro coffee and enjoy Chagga tribe activities. Meals will be at the Kaliwa Lodge with a good sight from the Lodge terrace you can relax and see the Kibo hut.

Dinner and the overnight stay will be at Kaliwa Lodge.

Day 2

Mount Kilimanjaro to Tarangire NP

You depart from Kaliwa Lodge after Breakfast and drive to Tarangire NP. Tarangire National Park offers a great variety in both scenery and wildlife; it is particularly famous for its large herd of elephants which you will get to see up close and in amazing detail. A great variety of animals call this park home including Lions, Zebras, Giraffes, Warthogs, Antelope and many different species of bird life. If you keep an eye on the tree tops you may be lucky enough to see a leopard lounging there or a python wrapped around a tree branch. At the end of the day you will be driven to your accommodation. Tarangire is one of Africa's little-known gems and it is magical. Boasting a variety of wildlife as diverse as its landscape, Tarangire is also the park that can boast being home to Tanzania's largest population of African elephants. With four of the Big Five also residing within the park.

Named for the Tarangire River which flows through it, the park is an excellent choice during the dry season when animals are forced to move closer and closer to the river in search of water. Set against a backdrop of majestic baobab trees and twisted acacia, it makes for a beautiful experience. The Great Rift Valley, which runs through Africa is a magical thing, we will pass it on our way from Tarangire to Karatu on our way to Serengeti.

After lunch you will be drive to Karatu town for relaxing and your overnight stay.

Early in the morning you will drive to Ngorongoro Crater for a full day game drive inside the crater. Ngorongoro is a large volcanic caldera that is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to a huge variety of animals. As you descend into the crater there is the feeling of entering a truly special place. The landscape is a mixture of forest, lakes and wide open plains that make it a perfect place for animal watching. Among the animals you can see here are black rhinoceros, lion, cheetah, hyena, jackal, hippos and many others. After a game drive you will have a picnic lunch at a site on the floor of the crater.
