Mount Kilimanjaro

Mount Kilimanjaro, towering over the area around Kaliwa Lodge, is Africa's highest peak at 5,895 meters. The lodge lies on the lush southern slopes, near the Machame Route, one of the most scenic paths to the summit. Surrounded by dense rainforests, banana plantations, and coffee farms, the region offers a cool, green environment with diverse wildlife and birdlife. The proximity to Kilimanjaro makes it an ideal base for hikers and nature lovers, with trails winding through waterfalls and Chagga villages, providing insight into the local culture and environment. On clear days, the lodge offers stunning views of the snow-capped peak.





Kaliwa Lodge is a boutique eco-lodge nestled in the rainforest near Kilimanjaro's Machame Gate. Perched at 1,300 meters, it offers serene views of the Weru Weru River Valley and features a wooden terrace with breathtaking views of Mount Kilimanjaro's summit. The lodge blends minimalist Bauhaus design with nature, featuring large-windowed bungalows and a strong commitment to sustainability.



Ngorongoro Crater

Ngorongoro Crater: A Natural Wonder of the World

The Ngorongoro Crater, located in northern Tanzania, is one of the most iconic and breathtaking natural wonders of Africa. Formed about 2 to 3 million years ago when a massive volcano exploded and collapsed on itself, the crater is the world's largest inactive, unbroken, and unfilled volcanic caldera. Spanning 260 square kilometers with a depth of about 600 meters, it creates a unique and self-contained ecosystem teeming with wildlife.

The crater is renowned for its incredible density of animals, making it one of the best places for wildlife viewing in the world. Within its steep walls, a diverse array of habitats—including grasslands, swamps, forests, and a soda lake—support over 25,000 large animals. One of the most striking aspects of the Ngorongoro Crater is its sheer beauty. The lush green of the crater floor, the sparkling waters of the lake, and the dramatic backdrop of the steep crater walls create a picturesque setting.

Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Ngorongoro Crater is not just a haven for wildlife but also a significant archaeological site, with Olduvai Gorge nearby, where some of the earliest human remains have been discovered.

Here, visitors can witness some of the best game viewing in Africa — lions lounging under acacia trees, leopards draped across branches, elephants wandering through golden plains, and endless herds of wildebeest and zebra.

The Central Serengeti is also known for its iconic scenery - open savannah dotted with granite kopjes that glow in the sunset light. It's an ideal place for both first-time safari travelers and photographers, offering dramatic landscapes and constant wildlife action throughout the year.




